

Description: High Angle Fire/Foreign Weapons Orientation Course

Course Cost: \$3,458 per student based on a five student minimum, additional students over five is an additional \$1,247, foreign weapons manuals and lodging for five nights at our facility

Scope of Course: MATR will provide a four (4)-day course of instruction on the application of high angle fire with your assigned weapons and familiarization of the AK-47/74, PKM Machine Gun, SVD Sniper Rifle, and the variations commonly seen with these weapons. Ammunition for the foreign weapons training is provided as are the weapons. Class size is capped at 12 students and closed courses are available. For beginners and professionals who need to understand and practice the firing up and down extreme angles of distances up to 500 meters. The high angle fire will be conducted in the morning and then the foreign weapons training will be in the afternoon.

The course will cover:

- High Angle Fire
 - High angle considerations and effect on trajectory of various US weapon systems
 - Shooting up and down angles at varied distances up to 500 meters
 - Low-light firing instruction
 - Optics
 - Tactical shooting drills and considerations

- Foreign Weapons
 - Safe and proper handling
 - Disassembly/Assembly
 - Basic maintenance
 - Ballistic considerations
 - Functioning of the weapon
 - Tactical shooting drills and considerations
 - Misfire/Stoppage drills
 - Sight adjustment/Battlefield zeroing
 - Implementation of the weapon as a modern battlefield rifle

Each registered student will receive a copy of the MATR-authored *Practical Guide to the Operational Use of the AK-47/AKM and AK-74 Rifles, PKM Machine Gun, SVD Sniper Rifle and RPG-7 Rocket Launcher* prior to the course for self-study. This item is a \$135 value.

Required to Bring for the High Angle portion of the training:

- Serviceable M4, 7.62mm AR platform, and/or bolt actions/carbine with sling and assigned optics
- Six (6) 30/20-round magazines with some type of magazine pouch; chest model is preferred
- Eye, ear, elbow, and knee protection (we can supply if needed)
- Suitable clothing for weather conditions
- Rounds per student: 1000 rounds for your assigned weapon of factory or surplus (no reloads) practice (ball). **Ammo may be purchased from MATR if arranged prior to class.**

All weapons, ammunition and support items for the foreign weapons will be provided as part of the course.
